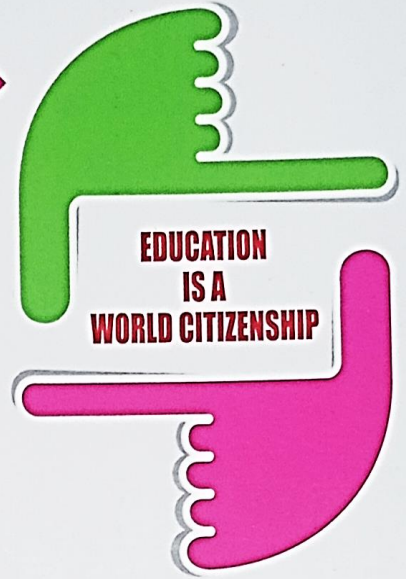

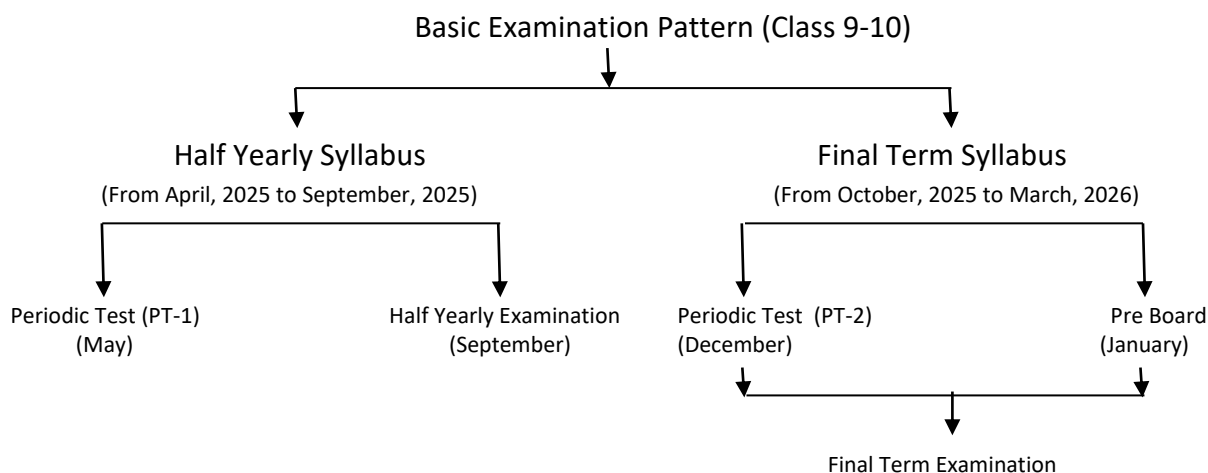

Labs Activities (Term – 1)

- 1.To represent graphically the relationship between total number of students in a class and the number of boys and girls, and to find out from the graph the number of girl in the class, when total number of boys is given.
2. To make a visual presentation of statistical data.
3. To verify that if a side of a triangle is produced, the exterior angle so formed is equal to the sum of two interior opposite angles, using the method of paper cutting and pasting.
- 4.To draw geometrical representation (graph) of a liner equation in two variables.

Labs Activities (Term – 2)

- 5.To verify that the angle subtended by an arc of a circle at the centre is twice the angle subtended by it at any point on the remaining part of the circle, using the method of paper cutting, folding and pasting
- 6.To obtain a formula for the lateral surface area of a right circular cylinder, using the method of paper cutting and pasting.

Labs Activities (Term – 1)

1. Preparation of stained temporary mounts of (a) onion peel, (b) human cheek cells & to record observations and draw their labeled diagrams.
2. Preparation of: a) A true solution of common salt, sugar and alum b) A suspension of soil, chalk powder and fine sand in water c) A colloidal solution of starch in water and egg albumin/milk in water and distinguish between these on the basis of- (Transparency, filtration criterion, stability)
3. Determination of the density of solid (denser than water) by using a spring balance and a measuring cylinder.
4. Identification of Parenchyma, Collenchyma and Sclerenchyma tissues in plants.
5. Perform the following reactions and classify them as physical or chemical changes.
 - a) Iron with copper sulphate solution in water
 - b) Burning of magnesium ribbon in air
 - c) Zinc with dilute sulphuric acid
 - d) Heating of copper sulphate crystals
 - e) Sodium sulphate with barium chloride in the form of their solutions in water.
6. Establishing the relation between the loss in weight of a solid when fully immersed in:
 - a) Tap water, b) Strongly water with the weight of water displaced by it by taking at least two different solids.
7. Identification of striped, smooth and cardiac muscle Fibers and nerve cells in animals, from prepared slides. Draw their labeled diagrams.
8. Determination of the melting point of ice and the boiling point of water.

9. Determination of the speed of a pulse propagated through a stretched string/slinky (helical spring).
